Young Carers



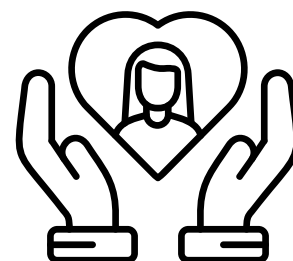
We are pleased to be running our Young Carers Support Group again this term.
